**SURVIVAL SKILLS:** What to do when things go wrong—from mechanical breakdowns to navigating the unexpected.

**MENTAL FORTITUDE:** Building the resilience needed for long, solo stretches and

challenging situations.





DAY **01** 

#### **MUMBAI | WORKSHOPS**

Start with a full day of learning. Get hands-on with motorcycle maintenance basics, from oil changes to puncture repairs. Dive into content creation with tips from the IBW team and Maral's world-ride experience, and prepare for emergencies with a practical first-aid and roadside response session.

**DAY 02** 

#### RIDE TO PANCHGANI | 250 KM

The first ride of the bootcamp takes you to Panchgani. At the campsite, learn how to cook and store food on the road, manage hygiene with minimal setups, pitch your tent, and prep your gear for real ride conditions.

**DAY 03** 

#### RIDE TO GOA | 400 KM

Take on a longer stretch to Goa, with a possible boat crossing en route. The evening is dedicated to open discussions, story sharing, and a detailed Q&A about the realities of a world ride.







### MECHANICAL WORKSHOPS

- Oil change
- Brake pad check and replacement
- Puncture repair basics
- Chain care and motorcycle check (Led by a professional mechanic)



### CONTENT SESSION

- Presentation by a GoPro representative or member of the IBW content team
- Insights from Maral's international riding content creation experience
- Discussion on what to film, how to film, and how to use content



### MEDICAL SESSION

- Roadside emergency response
- First-aid techniques specific to riding scenarios
- Recommended medical kit and safety checklist
